PRACTICE INTERVIEWS

Year 10 students had the opportunity to attend a 'practice interview' with some local business ambassadors with the purpose being to give students a chance to experience an interview within a safe, constructive and familiar space before they start thinking about the next part of their post 16 careers journey.







The session gave the students a taste of answering some interview questions as well as how to conduct themselves within a formal interview environment.

EXPERIENCE OF A WORKPLACE

Towards the end of June, over 170 Year 10 students experienced a two-day placement working within an organisation. The purpose of the placements were to help students see what a workplace in the future might look for them, how to behave and act as a professional within a working environment and the process and route to future employment. Students visited many different industries in the local area and we received some fantastic feedback.

"The student conducted themselves in a professional manner, arriving on time and following instructions well. They listened and was curious about the information shared to them when job shadowing in various departments within the organisation."

"Had a good positive attitude to the experience. Was willing to 'muck-in' and make themselves useful. This will get them far."

We have just launched 'Experience of a Workplace' with our current year 9 students who will have a fantastic opportunity to gain a two-day placement in the summer term of Year 10.
