They **DO NOT** accept:

Duvets and Blankets, Pillows and Cushions, Carpets, Rugs and Mats (including Bath, Shower and Toilet Mats), soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing, School uniforms with logo, corporate clothing and Workwear or Textile off cuts.
