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In our recent Year 8 Pathways Information Evening, we explained the pathways process and the choices available to your child. If you have not yet viewed this presentation you can find it on the school website under information; pathways.

Students have received a **Pathways Booklet** from their tutor and were asked to bring these home. This booklet provides all the information you will need about pathways and the subjects that students can choose. We recommend you read the information in this booklet carefully and spend time with your child talking about the subjects they may want to study.

All students will continue to study English, Mathematics, Science, Core PE, Education for Life, and **either** History **or** Geography.

Students will select and rank order three further subjects and one reserve choice. Most students will study the top choices they pick. Occasionally, we cannot offer students all one of their preferred choices. They must consider their reserve choice carefully.

Whilst it is not compulsory to study a language as part of our core curriculum, we believe all students should have the opportunity to continue learning a language and strongly recommend all students to continue studying the language they have studied in KS3.

**For a student to study the English Baccalaureate and continue studying their Modern Foreign Language they will need to select this subject within their three pathway choices.**

Pathways forms will be made available from Friday 8th March. Pathways choices must be made by Monday 18th March.

Further information regarding how to complete the Pathways Form will be sent nearer the time.

Students will receive plenty of guidance and support regarding the pathways process through the tutor programme and their Education for Life lessons. In addition, all students will take part in a subject taster lesson for every pathways subject.
