Students should be encouraged to prepare for these interviews at home by rehearsing typical interview questions like those below.

- Tell Me About Yourself.

- How Has Your Experience Prepared You for This Role?
- What Is Your Greatest Strength?
- What Is Your Greatest Weakness?
- How Do You Handle Stress and Pressure?
- What Are Goals for the Future?
- What are your hobbies or interests?

Interviews will last approximately 10 mins and the volunteers will also provide feedback to each student. Students should try to arrive 5 minutes before their interview and staff will be on hand on the day to support them.
