Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: Year 9 - Borough Market, London - Monday 3 July 2023

The Food Department would like to offer your child the opportunity to visit Borough Market; London's premier food market and award winning Bread Ahead Bakery School located within Borough Market. The trip includes a 1.5 hour practical workshop at Bread Ahead Bakery working under the expert guidance of the Chefs at Bread Ahead Bakery School, as well as a tour around Borough Market exploring the fresh produce and street food available. The students will be split into two groups once they arrive at Borough Market to ensure when they participate in the practical workshop they are in a smaller group; maximising the workshop experience. The focus of the trip is to develop practical cooking skills and gain an understanding of food provenance and the different types of food vendors within the Hospitality and Catering Industry.

The trip will take place on Monday 3 July 2023. Students will meet at 7.00am in front of the swimming pool by the coach. The coach will leave promptly at 7.15am. Students will travel by coach directly to Borough Market, London. The coach will return to school at approximately 5.30pm.

Students can bring a packed lunch if they wish or bring a small amount of money to purchase food from the street food market. Students will be preparing a Pizza during the workshop, so will be allowed to either eat the pizza for lunch or bring it home with them, suitable packing will be supplied by Bread Ahead Bakery. If your child is entitled to a free school meal lunch, this will be provided for them. Students will be representing the school on this trip so the highest standards of behaviour will be expected. Students are required to wear their full school uniform.

The cost of a place on the trip is £67.25 which covers the 1.5 hour practical workshop, inclusive of all ingredients and coach hire costs. This can be paid in full or split into 2 payments as follows, £37.25 due by 14 April 2023 and £30.00 due by 12 May 2023.

Please complete the parental agreement form online through your Parentpay account to give consent for your child to attend this trip. You will be asked to provide your emergency contact details and any relevant medical information. If a deposit, or full payment, is required this will also need to be paid at the time. If you have not already activated your Parentpay account and require your login details please do not hesitate to contact the Finance Office at finance@wildern.org.

If you have been notified that we as a school receive Pupil Premium funding for your child, the cost of this trip will be covered. If this is the case, your Parentpay account will automatically reflect this but please complete the consent, emergency contact information and medical details through Parentpay as usual. The same procedures regarding oversubscription for the trip will apply.

If you would like your child to attend please complete the online Parentpay medical and consent forms accompanied by a deposit payment of £37.25, or full payment of £67.25, by Friday 14 April 2023.

There are only 40 places available for this trip. In the event of oversubscription we will endeavour to take into consideration any students who may have missed out on trips previously due to oversubscription and will allocate any further places by drawing names out of a hat. In the event of a place not being allocated you will be informed and any monies received will be returned.

Teachers accompanying trips carry enormous responsibility for the students in their care. The Senior Leadership Team therefore reserve the right to refuse or withdraw a place to any student whose behaviour in school has been or becomes a problem.
