#### The Programme:

The programme takes place in the summer holidays over 2 or 3 consecutive weeks.

<u>Phase I</u> will give your teen the chance to test and challenge themselves by trying out new highoctane adventures. They will also stay away from home (if they choose a three-week programme) and have food and transport provided.

<u>Phase 2</u> Your teen will learn the skills needed for work, further education, and independent living. Completing various workshops to enhance their skills and increase their self-confidence, your teen will pick up a lot in this phase.

**Phase 3** will allow your teen to plan their own project for a cause that's close to their heart and then action it to help their local communities and really make a difference.
