Dear Parent/Guardian

We are about to embark on an exciting phase for Year 8 students who will be opting for the pathways they will study in Years 9, 10 and 11.

In our recent Year 8 Pathways WINK, we explained the pathways process and the choices available to your child. If you have not yet viewed this presentation we recommend you do, so that you are fully prepared to support your child. Students will receive a Pathways Booklet from their tutor and are expected to bring these home. This booklet provides all the information you will need about pathways and the subjects that students can opt for. We recommend you read the information in this booklet carefully and spend time with your child talking about the subjects they may want to study.

All students will continue to study English, Mathematics, Science, Core PE, MSS, and either History or Geography.

Whilst it is not compulsory to study a language as part of our core curriculum, we believe all students should have the opportunity to continue learning a language and strongly recommend all students to continue studying the language they have studied in KS3.

For a student to study the English Baccalaureate **they will need to select a Modern Foreign Language within their pathway choices.**

**Pathways forms will be emailed as a google form on Friday 18 March. Forms must be completed by Monday 28 March.**

Students will receive further guidance and information regarding the pathways process through the tutor programme, their MSS lessons and assemblies. All students will take part in a subject taster lesson and information videos for each subject will be shared through the tutor programme.
