Chief Medical Officer Announcement - Change in Length of Isolation Period

On Friday the Chief Medical Officer announced a change to the self-isolation period from 14 to 10 days.

This new guidance comes into effect from Monday 14 December and will apply to all those who are currently self-isolating including those who commenced self-isolation before Monday. Self-isolation periods will begin on the day after:

- exposure
- a test or
- the start of symptoms.

The NHS Test and Trace service will be telling people to self-isolate for 10 days instead of 14 days from 14 December.

Any schools that have students or staff who are in self-isolation and due to return to school on Wednesday 16 December 2020 - if well enough – could feasibly return on Monday 14 December, because the new guidance applies retrospectively.

We are aware that this guidance was released late on Friday and so if you have a young person isolating and due back on Wednesday, we know that you will want to ensure that they return in a coordinated and safe way and as quickly as you are safely able to do so.

We look forward to seeing everyone for this last week of the term.
