Re: Year 9 - Design and Technology - Warner Bros. Studio Tour - The Making of Harry Potter - Monday 13 November 2023

In order to enrich the Design and Technology curriculum, the Wildern Design and Technology department has organised a trip to visit the Warner Bros. Studio Tour London - The Making of Harry Potter. Students will have full access to the studio tour and explore the making of the films, with a focus on the real world applications of Design and Technology such as costume making, prop design and movie graphic design. Students will also be taking part in a workshop, led by an industry expert, getting a behind the scenes look at how the film sets were designed, prototyped and made.

The cost of the trip is £42.00.

This trip is taking place on Monday 13 November 2023, when the students will be starting year 10, and is a fantastic opportunity for students to enhance their Design and Technology knowledge. Due to the popularity of this style of trip, we are having to book seven months in advance. **There are 60 places available.**

Students will be leaving school at 8am and returning at approximately 5pm. All students will require a packed lunch and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them.

Students will be representing the school on this trip so the highest standards of behaviour will be expected. Students are required to wear full school uniform.

You will be asked to provide your emergency contact details and any relevant medical information. If a deposit, or full payment, is required this will also need to be paid at the time. In the event of a place not being allocated you will be informed and any monies received will be returned.
