Year 9 and 10 trip to Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew - 13th May 2025

The Science department would like to offer your child the opportunity to visit the Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew. The trip includes entry to the gardens and a 45 minute workshop, focussing on the photosynthesis and Gas Exchange. The aim of the trip is to provide students with the opportunity to discover the complex way plants have adapted to cope with limiting factors such as temperature and the effect of these on photosynthesis and gas exchange.

The trip will take place on 13th May. Students will meet at 8.00am in front of the swimming pool by the coach. Students will travel by coach and will leave school promptly at 8.15am and return at approximately 4:30pm (we will be aiming to leave Kew Gardens at 2:45pm). All students will require a packed lunch and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them.
