Wildern School - Exam Results Information

The purpose of this guide is to clarify the information on your Candidate Statement of Results.

All pupils will have GCSE results; some pupils will also have BTEC. All of these results, (with the exception of BTEC), will be listed on this Statement of Results. Those who took the BTEC qualifications will have a photocopy of their certificate which confirms their final result, in their results envelope.

The Candidate Statement of Results has your personal details: name, date of birth, candidate number etc and the Exam season when you took your exams; June 2024. It then lists your exam results under the following headings:

Board: This is the Exam Board for the qualification taken e.g. AQA, Edexcel and OCR

Level: This signifies the type of exam e.g. GCSE.

(GCSE/B = unit result, GCSE/FC = Full Course, Final Grade,)

Element Code: Numerical code for the exam.

Title: Name of the exam e.g. English, Maths, Science

Grd1: This is the final grade awarded, shown as a number 9-1. This is your actual exam

result. Numbers will appear for all subjects except Imedia. Please see the

guidance from the DfE for more information on this grading.

Mark: The mark awarded for the unit.

Equivalent: The grade that mark equates to for the unit, shown as a lower case letter, or the

total marks awarded for the final grade.

Points: The points each grade is worth in terms of the performance measures for the

school.

END 1: This is the English Language Speaking and Listening Endorsement mark. This

does not count towards the overall grade but students do need to complete this to

receive a final grade.
