I am writing to inform you that we have now launched the GCSE Media Studies Non-Exam Assessment for 2024-25 (NEA).

The NEA in Media Studies is worth 30% of the final grade and so we encourage them to complete the project to the best of their ability.

## Students will be expected to:

- Plan their advertisements in lesson
- Take the photographs or footage as Self Study (due 24th September 2024)
- Make the advertisements in lesson

Teaching staff are here to support students; we run a weekly lunchtime clinic and regular after school sessions where students can speak to us if they have any questions or concerns and use the equipment at school as needed.

## The key deadlines that you should be aware of are:

13/12/24 Deadline for NEA to be submitted to class teacher

- Encouraging your son / daughter to discuss with you their plans for the photographs / footage they hope to take or film
- Helping them carve out time after school or at the weekend to film / photograph this
- Encouraging your son / daughter to attend lunch time clinics when support is needed
- Encouraging your son / daughter to attend all of their Media Studies lessons so that they do not fall behind on the NEA
