- Punctuality: Persistent concerns with arriving on time.
- Attitudes to Learning: Inconsistent effort or poor attitudes to learning, including:
 - o Persistently not completing self-study on time or to the required standard.
 - Failing to bring the necessary equipment and being unprepared for lessons.
 - Failing to demonstrate respect toward teachers and peers.
- Attitude Grades or EREF Scores: Poor grades across subjects and/or negative EREF scores.
- Uniform Compliance: Persistent breaches of the uniform code.
- **School Rules:** Repeatedly breaking rules, such as using mobile phones or headphones inappropriately.

We are looking forward to celebrating with our Year 11 students and hope to make this a truly memorable occasion.
